

Double Negatives

Double negatives are using two negatives in a phrase or sentence. When we use negative words such as no, nobody and nothing in a sentence, we don't generally use a negative verb. Otherwise, the sentence would be considered faulty.

Jasper didn't write no assignment.

Faulty



Jasper didn't write any assignment.

Correct



Nobody didn't fail in the exam.

Faulty



Nobody failed in the exam.

Correct
