



Asteroid Belt




An asteroid belt is the circumstellar disc with millions of asteroids in the solar system. It is found between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter.

Solar System



The Sun, planets, satellites, asteroids, meteoroids and comets form the solar system. The solar system is 4.568 billion years old.

Galaxy




A galaxy is a huge collection of billions of stars held together by gravity.

Constellation



A group of stars that form imaginary patterns in the night sky. There are 88 official modern constellations of which Hydra is the largest.

Rocket



A rocket is a space vehicle which is used to launch people and objects into space. The first rocket was launched by Germany in 1942.

Telescope



A telescope is an optical instrument designed to make distant objects appear nearer. Galileo Galilei built the first astronomical telescope.

Satellite



A satellite is an object that orbits the planets or stars. Man-made satellites are widely used for communication purposes.

Galaxy



A galaxy is a huge collection of billions of stars held together by gravity.

Constellation



A group of stars that form imaginary patterns in the night sky. There are 88 official modern constellations of which Hydra is the largest.
