

Adding Doubles Minus Two

Use adding doubles minus 2 strategy and write the sum of each.

Example: $5 + 3$

$$\begin{aligned} 5 + 3 &= 5 + 5 - 2 \\ &= 10 - 2 \\ &= \mathbf{8} \end{aligned}$$
