## Adding Doubles Plus One

Use adding doubles plus 1 strategy and write the sum of each.

Example:  $4 + 5$

$$\begin{aligned}4 + 5 &= 4 + 4 + 1 \\ &= 8 + 1 \\ &= \mathbf{9}\end{aligned}$$
