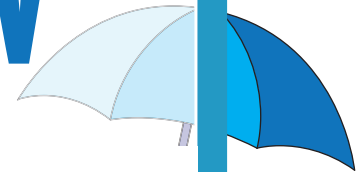


**Articles - a/an/the**

 Articles → **A** - Use "a" with singular nouns beginning with a consonant sound.

Example: Brenda visited an arboretum.
