

# First Conditionals

The first conditional talks about things that might happen in the future. To form a first conditional, we use the present simple in the "if/when" clause and the future simple in the other clause.

**Example :** Maria (accompany) us to Paris if we (pay) for the hotel.  
Maria will accompany us to Paris if we pay for the hotel.
