

Zero Conditionals

The zero conditional refers to general habits or scientific truths. We use the simple present tense in both parts of a zero-conditional sentence.

Zero conditionals are formed with 'if' or 'when'.

Example: Mom/usually call/she late

Mom usually calls when she's late.
