Articles:

a, an, and the

Demonstratives:

this, that, these,
and those

Possessives:

my, your, his, her,
our, their, and
its

Numbers:

cardinals such as "one"
and "two", and ordinals
such as
"first" and
"second"

Quantifiers:

much, many,
a few, a little etc.

Interrogatives:

which, what,
whose
etc.

A determiner is a word that introduces a noun. It always comes before a noun or a noun phrase. It provides an identity, specification, or quantity to the noun.

Examples

an apple
this year
