

Determiners and Quantifiers

Both the phrases "**a few**" and "**a little**" are quantifiers meaning some. While "**a few**" is used with countable nouns, "**a little**" accompanies uncountable nouns.

Example : The doctor prescribed **a few** pills for the cold.

Is there **a little** medicine left in the bottle?
