## DIRECT OBJECT

- ★ A **direct object** receives the action of a verb.
- ★ It answers the question of what or who.

Examples:

**Subject** + **Verb** + **Direct object**

1) Ella bought a meat sandwich.  
**S**      **V**                      **DO**

In the above sentence, a meat sandwich is the direct object, as it answers the question, "What did Ella buy?"

2) I met Anna.  
**S**   **V**   **DO**

Here, Anna is the answer to the question, "Who did I meet?"

## INDIRECT OBJECT

- ★ An **indirect object** is the recipient of a direct object.
- ★ It informs to whom or for whom something is being done.

Examples:

**Subject** + **Verb** + **Indirect object** + **Direct object**

Jeremy bought his grandfather a walking stick.  
**S**      **V**                      **IO**                      **DO**

In this example, "his grandfather" is the recipient of the walking stick, hence "his grandfather" is the indirect object.
