A **direct object** receives the action of a verb, while an **indirect object** tells who received the result or benefit of a verb.

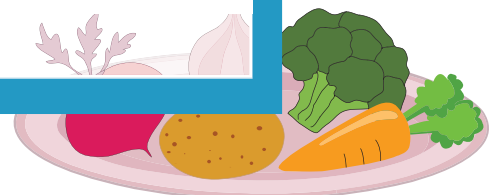
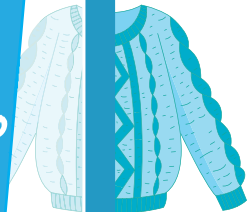
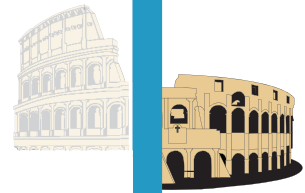
