

Homophones

The words **its** and **it's** are homophones. They sound the same, but have different meanings.

Its is the possessive form of **it**, meaning belonging to something already mentioned.

Example: The house has a beautiful garden with **(its)** own fountain.

It's is the contracted form of **it is** or **it has**.

Example: **(It's)** his birthday tomorrow.
