

Homophones

The words **its** and **it's** are homophones. They sound the same, but have different meanings.

Its is the possessive form of **it**, meaning belonging to something already mentioned.

Example: The dog ate (**its**) food.

It's is the contracted form of **it is** or **it has**.

Example: (**It's**) important to eat a healthy breakfast every day.
