

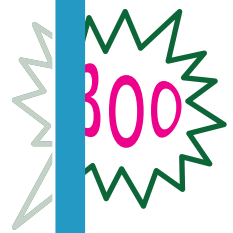
Interjections

An **interjection** is a word or phrase that is grammatically independent from the words around it. It expresses feeling rather than meaning.

Example: I finally made it to the bus just in time.
