Possessive Nouns

Possessive nouns are nouns that show ownership or possession.

Example: Smith's daughter, The Millers' farm, Kids' playground

How to Form Possessive Nouns

a) For singular nouns that end with a vowel and a consonant, add an apostrophe and an "s".

Example:

Ex

ss's son,

b) For singular nouns that end with an "s", add an apostrophe.

Example:

"s", add

c) For plural nouns that don't end with an "s", add an apostrophe and an "s".

Example: Children's books, Women's clothes, People's party
