

## Infinitive Phrases

An **infinitive phrase** is a group of words consisting of an infinitive and any of its modifiers and complements. Infinitive phrases can act as nouns, adjectives, or adverbs in sentences.

**Example:** \_\_\_\_\_ has the opportunity to win a full-ride scholarship.
