

Prepositional Phrases

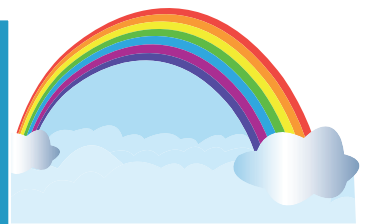
When prepositional phrases are used as adverbs, they modify verbs, adjectives, other adverbs, or complete sentences.

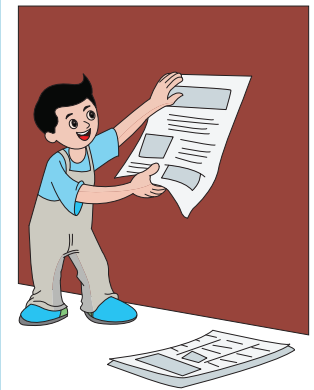
