





# Demonstrative Pronouns

A **demonstrative pronoun** is used to point to something specific within a sentence. "This" and "these" are used for nearby objects, and "that" and "those" are used for faraway things. "This" and "that" are singular and "these" and "those" are plural.

Example:

Singular	Plural
 This is a ball.	 These are balls.
 That is a ball.	 Those are balls.


