An **indefinite pronoun** is a pronoun that doesn't represent a person, place, or thing in particular.

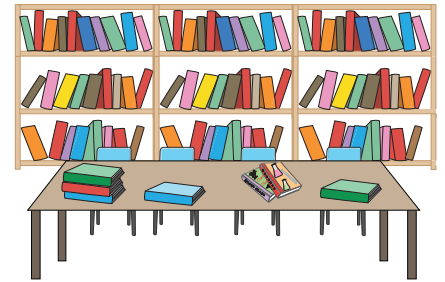
