

Simple, Compound, and Complex Sentences

A **compound sentence** joins two or more independent clauses with a comma and conjunction or a semicolon.

Example: Serena loves gardening. Serena plants flowers in her backyard.

Serena loves gardening, so she plants flowers in her backyard.
