

Simple, Compound, and Complex Sentences

A **compound sentence** joins two or more independent clauses with a comma and conjunction or a semicolon.

Example: Hayley plays basketball. Hayley also plays volleyball.

Hayley plays basketball, and she also plays volleyball.
