## Compound Subjects

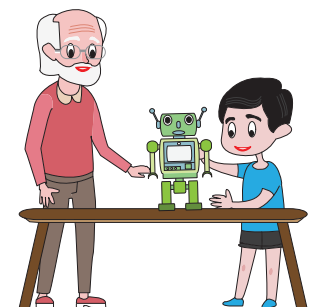
