The subject and verb in a sentence must agree with each other in number. A singular subject will have a singular verb, and a plural subject will have a plural verb.

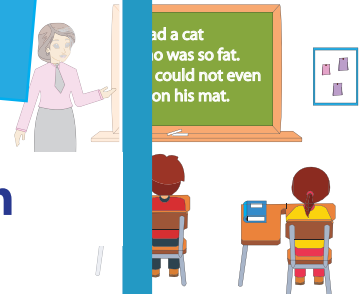
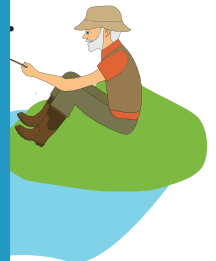
Example The kitten sleeps (sleeps/sleep) on the couch.
