

Syllabication - VC/CV

- VC/CV** - Words are separated into syllables when two spoken vowels are separated by two consonants.
 - The consonants can be the same or different.

Example - magnet mag/net
 The two spoken vowels sounds are short a and short e.
 They are separated by the two consonants g and n.
