









# Six Syllable Types

SYLLABLE TYPE	HINT	EXAMPLE
<b>Closed Syllable</b> <i>Ends with a consonant with a short vowel sound before it.</i> 	Short sound CVC VC/CV	 dog
<b>Open Syllable</b> <i>Ends with a long vowel sound.</i>	Long sound	 do-nut
<b>R-Control</b> <i>An "r" controls the sound of the vowel that is before it.</i>		 purse
<b>Silent-e</b> <i>A main long vowel followed by a silent "e" sound.</i>		 bone
<b>Vowel Team</b> <i>Two vowels work together to make a long, short or diphthong vowel sound.</i> 	oa, ea	 cloud
<b>Consonant-le Syllable</b> <i>A consonant + letters "l" and "e" come at the end of the syllable.</i> 	ending syllable c + le	 ap-ple

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
