Present simple	I work eight hours a day, don't I?	I don't work eight hours a day, do I?
Past simple	They laughed a lot, didn't they?	They didn't laugh a lot, did they?
Past progressive	She was sleeping, wasn't she?	She wasn't sleeping, was she?
Present perfect	I have read three books, haven't I?	I haven't read three books, have I?
Past perfect	They had visited Canada, hadn't they?	They hadn't visited Canada, had they?
Future simple	I will wash the dishes today, won't I?	I won't wash the dishes today, will I?
Modal verbs	Emily could cook dinner without an oven, couldn't she?	Emily couldn't cook dinner without an oven, could she?
