

Tag Questions

Tag questions, also called question tags, are phrases added at the end of a sentence, and they change normal sentences into interrogative sentences. If the sentence is positive, the tag is negative; if the sentence is negative, the tag is positive.

Example: You would like some jelly on your toast, wouldn't you?
