

Past Progressive Tense

Construction: was / were + verb ing

Functions: 1. To express a continuing action at some point in the past

Example: When her friends came over, Lucy was eating lunch.

2. To describe a repeated action in the past

Example: Daniel was swimming twice a day, the whole summer last year.

3. To express a change of mind or to make a polite request using "wonder"

Example: I was wondering if I could eat some more ice cream.

4. To describe an action that was interrupted by another action

Example: I was cooking dinner, when someone knocked at the door.
