## Future Progressive Tense

### Construction: will be + verb ing

**Functions:** 1. To refer to an event that will continue for a while in the future

Example: In June, Emily will be holidaying abroad.

2. To predict or guess future events

Example: I guess you will be getting married next year.

3. To indicate that a longer action in the future will be interrupted by a shorter action

Example: When Mr. Smith will be watching news on TV.
