

Simple Present Tense

Functions: 1. To express habits or general truths

Example: Birds sing beautiful songs. (sing)

2. To express exclamation or fixed events

Example: The school bell rings at 3:00 pm sharp. (ring)

3. To express future time after selected conjunctions, such as after, when, before, and as soon as

Example: When it rains, you can use an umbrella. (rain)
