

Helping Verbs

A **helping verb, or auxiliary verb**, precedes the main verb in a sentence. It adds details, such as time and mood, to the main verb.

Example: Ralph and Roger had been playing in the pool since morning.

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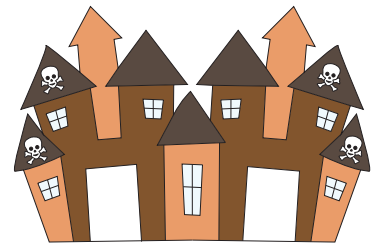
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
