- 4) There are 14 trees in a park. 5 of them are evergreens. How many are deciduous trees?

- 5) Leo has 14 action figures. He has 5 more than the number of books he has. How many books does he have?

- 6) John starts with 5 books. He wants an odd total that's still below 11. What number of books should he add?

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
