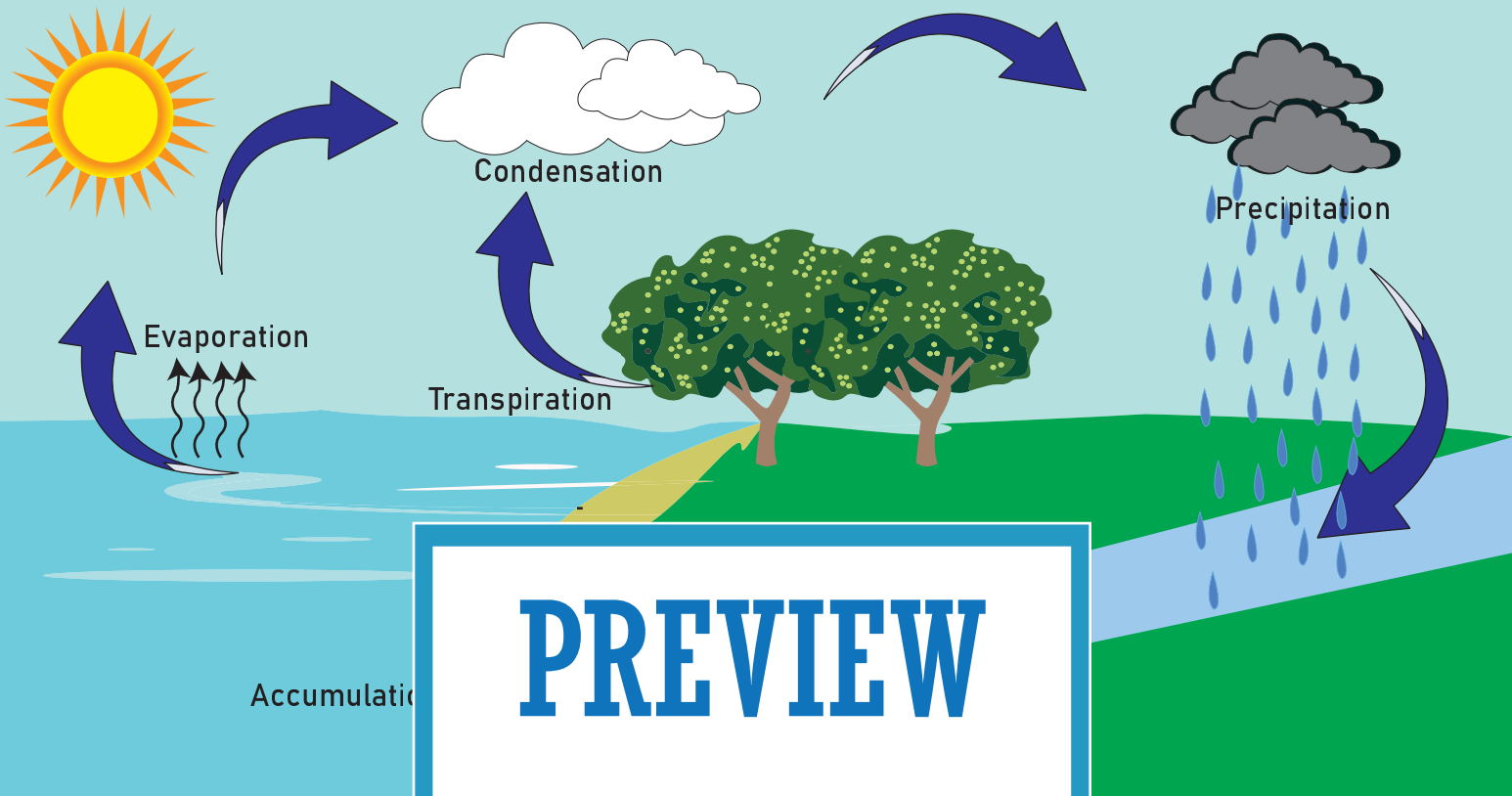

### Condensation

### Transpiration

### Surface Runoff

Precipitation that reaches the Earth's surface but does not infiltrate the soil is called surface runoff.
