

Subtraction



Snakes and Ladders

Object of the game:

To subtract numbers with a pair of dice and get to the finish point. The first player to reach the finish point the winner!

Things needed:

A pair of dice and colored paper for Snakes and Ladders.

Instructions:

Two to four players.

All players will roll the dice one, two, three, and four. The player with the highest number goes first.

On each roll of a pair of dice, the player marks the number on a piece of paper and moves their counter.

Based on the difference between the numbers on the board. If a player lands on a snake, they subtract the number indicated by the snake's head up to move ahead in the game.

You get an extra turn if you land on a ladder.

The first person to reach the finish point is the winner.

Learning Outcome:

This board game will help a child enhance their ability at subtracting numbers in a flash. It will also hone their social language and behavioral skills.
