

Example :



$$\begin{aligned} \text{Perimeter} &= 16 \text{ ft} \\ \text{Perimeter} &= 4 \times \text{Side} \\ 16 \text{ ft} &= 4 \times \text{Side} \\ \frac{16}{4} &= \text{Side} \\ \text{Side} &= \mathbf{4 \text{ ft}} \end{aligned}$$






