- 2) In the bulletin board at her dad's office, Emily saw 12 thumbtacks arranged in 6 columns of equal numbers. How many thumbtacks did each column contain?

- 3) Charles arranged 24 pebbles in 4 rows, with an equal number of pebbles, how many pebbles were in each row?

- 4) After the class finished their lesson, Mr. Smith hangs the keys on a board in 3 columns. How many keys are in each column?

- 5) Mary arranged 20 roses in 4 columns, each column presenting a distinct color. She collected an equal number of red, yellow, pink and orange roses. How many red roses were there?
