Its vs It's

The words **its** and **it's** are homophones. They sound the same, but have different meanings.

Its is a possessive form of **it**, meaning belonging to something already mentioned.

Example: The puppy slept in **(its)** kennel.

It's is the contracted form of **it is** or **it has**.

Example: **(It's)** a beautiful house.

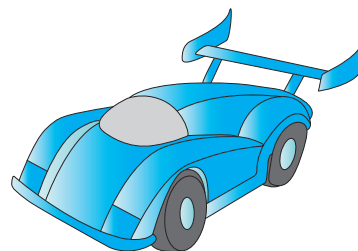
