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a) Find the number of teenagers who like reading sports magazines in reading sports magazines.

b) How many teenagers like reading Runner's World?

c) What number of teenagers like both magazines?

- 2) A TV channel surveyed 100 people about their favorite talk shows. "The Mayer Show" (M) got 58 likes and "The Smith Show" (S) got 42 likes. Ten people like watching both the shows. Represent the data in a Venn diagram.
