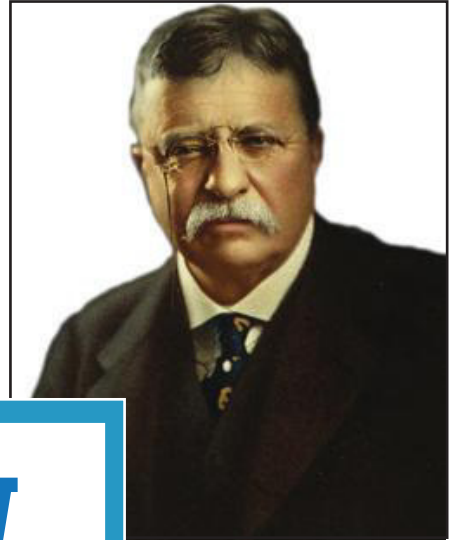


Theodore Roosevelt
