Dependent Clauses

An **independent clause** is a group of words which includes a subject and a verb, and contains a complete thought. Independent clauses can stand alone as sentences.

A **dependent** / **subordinate clause** is a group of words which includes a subject and a verb, but doesn't contain a complete thought. Dependent clauses cannot stand alone as sentences.

Example: When Mom came home, I was watching TV.
